PURPOSE

The Nathan L. Anderson Memorial Scholarship Foundation was established to honor the life of the late Nathan L. Anderson. In his honor, the foundation provides scholarships to assist minority students pursuing college degrees in areas that were of importance to him.

The purpose of this 501 (c)(3) tax -exempt Private Operating Foundation is to provide scholarship assistance and mentoring career guidance to minority undergraduate college students who pursue training that leads to a Bachelor-level degree in one of these four disciplines:

- 1) Computer Science;
- 2) Aviation;
- 3) Nursing;
- 4) Music.

- ▣ The Foundation focuses on supporting those four disciplines because the life and interests of Lieutenant (LT) Nathan L. Anderson, USPHS encompassed all of those areas.
- ▣ By professional training, he was a Computer Scientist; he was a licensed Private Pilot; and he was a formally-trained, highly-gifted musician, as are both of his sisters, Nicole and Nichelle.



2024 Expense Breakout


